The library is a quiet place for reading, studying, and researching, and to provide better library services, kindly you are requested to adhere to the following rules:

- Comply with the rules and regulations for the behavior controls stipulated in the university bylaws.
- Eating, drinking and smoking are prohibited inside the library (only bottle water is allowed).
- Keep quiet inside the library.
- Don't use your mobile phones inside the library or use silent mode on mobile phones.
- No personal belongings should be left inside the library. The library is not responsible in case of losing it.
- Maintaining the cleanliness of the place and not leaving waste and water bottles on tables or between shelves, and they must be thrown in the places designated for them.
- Correct use of library equipment, collectibles, and furniture, to protect it from damage or malfunctions.
- After using a chair, kindly return it to its place.
- Kindly do not return the resources (books, thesis, publications, and manuscripts) to shelves after using them, just leave them on the reception table.
- Do not damage Library books and journals, by removing pages or portions of pages, marking, highlighting, or underlining text.
- Cooperate with the library staff and follow their instructions and directions, as they are there to serve you.
- Dealing with Library Staff and visitors in the best way to create an environment of mutual respect.
- Anyone who refuses to comply with the policy will be asked to leave the building, and it might result in the loss of the library privileges. Some violations of this policy will be subject to legal actions.
